

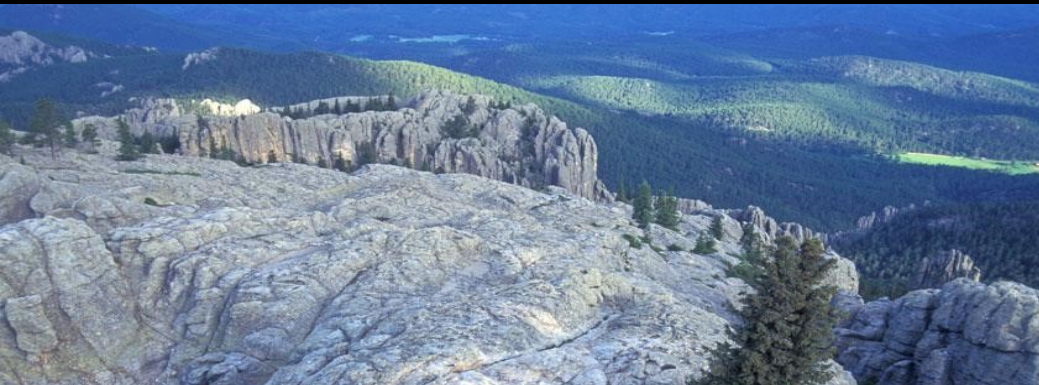

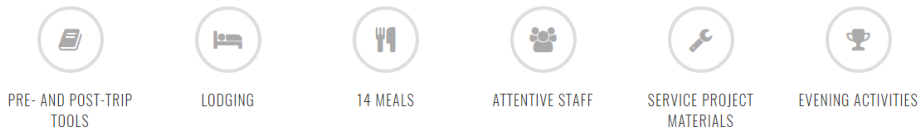

What Happens During A Typical YouthWorks Day?

A typical YouthWorks day includes so much. Youth will assist in meal preparations, participate in personal devotion time, work at the various ministry sites, experience fun and cultural evening activities and engage in a “club time” that includes worship, games, skits and prayer.

The ministry work incorporates a variety of opportunities to serve. Our group will serve local service agencies and work with children and the elderly. We may serve all or part of the week at a food shelf, clothing distribution center, soup kitchen, children’s program or elder care facility. One of the most interesting organizations we work with is Black Hills Works, a progressive and adaptive center for mentally and physically challenged adults in Rapid City. Their center provides job training, paid work, practical life classes and other services.

We will be able to see Mount Rushmore, but we’ll also learn about other aspects of Rapid City, such as the importance of the Black Hills to the Lakota. You’ll also participate in the largest cookout in our Western region. YouthWorks has partnered with this community since 1999.
