Mold Killer Recipe:

To kill mold spores and their roots, pour straight 3% peroxide (H₂O₂), undiluted, into a spray bottle and saturate the surface with it. Let the H₂O₂ do its work for 10 to 15 minutes, and scrub the walls to remove all dead mold. You can add vinegar to the H₂O₂ in the spray bottle to make the solution stronger.
